Feinglos , 2005 n=61/61 follow-up: 16 weeks	2.5 mg glipizide GITS versus placebo	type 2 diabetes inadequately controlled (A1c 7-8.5%) on metformin (>or =1000 mg/day for >or =3 months)	double-blind
