isosorbide mononitrate vs placebo			
Fitzgerald , 1990 n=184/176 follow-up: 6 mo	oral isosorbide 5-mononitrate (ISMN) for 5 days versus placebo	patients with suspected acute myocardial infarction	Parallel groups double blind England
Hargreaves , 1992 n=33/18 follow-up: 28 days	20 mg of isosorbide mononitrate three times daily for 28 days versus placebo	patients with acute myocardial infarction (systolic blood pressure >90 mm Hg) within 24 hours of the start of pain	Parallel groups double blind
ISIS-4 , 1995 n=29018/29032 follow-up: 5 weeks	oral controlled-release mononitrate 30 mg initial dose titrated up to 60 mg once daily for 1 month versus placebo	patients with suspected acute myocardial infarction up to 24h	Parallel groups double blind worldwide
