nifedipine vs trichlormethiazide			
NICS-EH, 1999 n=215/214 follow-up: 4.5 years	Nifedipine SR 20mg twice daily versus trichlormethiazide 2mg once daily	>=60 years of age with systolic blood pressure of 160 to 220 mm Hg and diastolic blood pressure <115 mm Hg	Parallel groups Double blind
