Murphy , 2003 n=120 follow-up: 30 days	roxifiban 0.25, 0.5, 0.75, 1, 1.25, 1.5, 2, or 2.5 mg/day for up to 30 days versus placebo	patients with stable coronary artery disease	Parallel groups double blind
