ECRIS , 2003 n=113/112 follow-up: 6 mo	Intracoronary beta-irradiation with a rhenuim-188-filled balloon catheter versus no additional intervention	patients with de novo and restenotic lesions	Parallel groups open Germany
SPARE , 2004 n=104/83 follow-up: 9mo (3y)	rhenuim-188 filled balloon system versus control	patient with successful catheter-based treatment of de novo or restenotic lesion	Parallel groups open Korea
P-32 vs placebo			
PREVENT , 2000 n=80/25 follow-up: 6 mo	intracoronary radiotherapy with the beta-emitting (32)P, 16, 20, or 24 Gy to a depth of 1 mm in the artery wall versus sham procedure	patients with de novo (70%) or restenotic (30%) lesions who were treated by stenting (61%) or balloon angioplasty (39%)	Parallel groups double blind US
INHIBIT , 2002 n=166/166 follow-up: 9 mo	intracoronary beta radiation with a phosphorus-32 source versus placebo	patients with in-stent restenosis and successful coronary intervention	Parallel groups double blind US
START , 2000 n=244/232 follow-up: 8 mo	intracoronary radiation with 90Sr/90Y source versus placebo	patients with in-stent restenosis	Parallel groups double blind US

SCRIPPS , 1997 n=26/29 follow-up: 6 mo	catheter-based irradiation with iridium-192 versus placebo	patients with restenosis	Parallel groups double blind US
WRIST , 2001 n=65/65 follow-up: 6 mo	intracoronary gamma-radiation with (192)Ir 15 Gy versus placebo	presented with symptoms of angina and angiographic evidence of in-stent restenosis	Parallel groups double blind
GAMMA-ONE , 2001 n=131/121 follow-up: 9 mo	intracoronary radiotherapy with iridium-192 versus placebo	patients with in-stent restenosis	Parallel groups double blind US
SVG-WRIST , 2002 n=60/60 follow-up: 12 mo	intravascular treatment with a ribbon containing iridium-192 versus placebo	patients with in-stent restenosis in saphenous-vein grafts	Parallel groups double blind US
Long-WRIST , 2003 n=60/60 follow-up: 1 y	gamma radiation with 192Ir versus placebo	patients with diffuse long in-stent restenosis in native coronary arteries (lesion length, 36 to 80 mm)	Parallel groups double blind US
