<b>BEECH</b> <i>ongoing</i> [NCT01625286] n=NA follow-up:	AZD5363 in combination with paclitaxel versus placebo in combination with paclitaxel	patients with estrogen receptor-positive advanced or metastatic breast cancer, including a subgroup who have the phosphoinositide-3-kinase, catalytic, alpha polypeptide (PIK3CA) tumour mutation
