apixaban (without LMWH) vs LMWH/VKA			
AMPLIFY , 2013 [NCT00643201] n=2691/2704 follow-up: 6 mo	apixaban 10 mg twice daily for 7 days then 5 mg, twice daily, 6 months versus conventional therapy: enoxaparin 1mg/kg twice daily until INR>=2 then warfarin for an INR between 2-4, once daily, 6 months	patients with deep vein thrombosis or pulmonary embolism	Parallel groups double blind
Botticelli DVT , 2008 [NCT00252005] n=358/118 follow-up:	apixaban 5 mg twice-daily, 10 mg twice-daily, or 20 mg once-daily for 84-91 days versus low molecular weight heparin followed by vitamin K antagonists	patients with symptomatic deep vein thrombosis	Parallel groups open
